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Purpose

This guide explains how winners should use the Human-Centered Design Award mark and badge correctly and consistently across different applications.

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Award Identity System

The system includes two elements: the Offline Mark for physical use and the Online Badge for digital platforms, ensuring consistent representation across all touchpoints.

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Human-Centered Design Award

This international award celebrates solutions that put people first—designs that inspire, uplift, and create meaningful progress for individuals and communities. From enhancing everyday experiences to shaping systems for the greater good, the Award recognises those who design with purpose and empathy.



Human-Centered Design Logo

The Human-Centred Design logo embodies the principle of placing people at the heart of design.

The stylised human figure at the centre of the circle represents how innovation begins with needs, aspirations and experiences.

The orange colour conveys energy, warmth and creativity, symbolising optimism and the drive to design with empathy and purpose.

The circular form symbolises unity and inclusiveness. The logo reflects a commitment to human-centred design as a foundation for meaningful progress.

Purpose of This Guide

This guide provides clear direction on how to use the Human-Centered Design Award mark and badge correctly and consistently. It is designed for winners to understand which badge or mark to use, how to apply them across different materials, and how to maintain the integrity and recognition of the award identity.

Offline Mark Clear Space

Always maintain sufficient clear space around the mark to preserve its integrity, visibility, and visual impact.



The clear space around the mark is 1/2 of the symbol on all sides.

Offline Mark Minimum Size

To maintain legibility and brand integrity, the mark must never be displayed below the minimum size specified. This ensures clarity across all offline applications. When scaling the mark, always maintain its proportions to prevent distortion.

Offline Mark Colour Formats

To maintain brand consistency across various backgrounds and applications, the mark is available in multiple colour formats. These variations ensure optimal legibility and adaptability in different contexts.



Offline Mark Black and White Formats

The mark may be used in black and white when colour reproduction is not possible or when simplicity is required. These formats ensure the mark remains clear, legible, and consistency.



Offline Mark Misuses

To maintain brand consistency, the mark should always be used correctly. Below are examples of incorrect usage of the mark.



Do not stretch or warp the mark in anyway.



Do not change any of the colour in the mark.



Do not attempt to apply strokes in anyway.



Do not apply any special effects to the mark.



Do not adjust saturation, brightness, contrast, or any other visual attributes within the mark.



Do not placed the mark on similarly-coloured background.

Vertical Layout



Structure & Clear Spacing

Maintain clear space equal to 1/2 of the symbol around the entire mark.



Minimum Size

Ensure the badge is never displayed smaller than 8mm in height to maintain legibility.

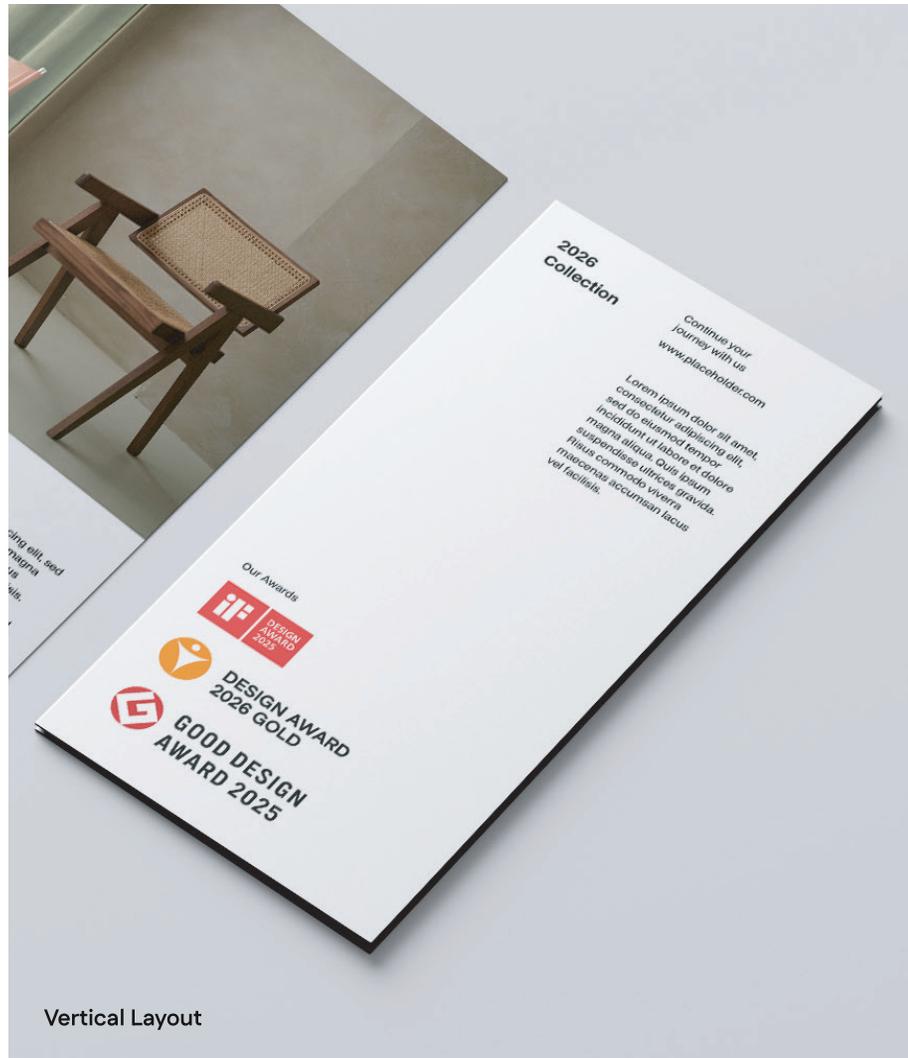

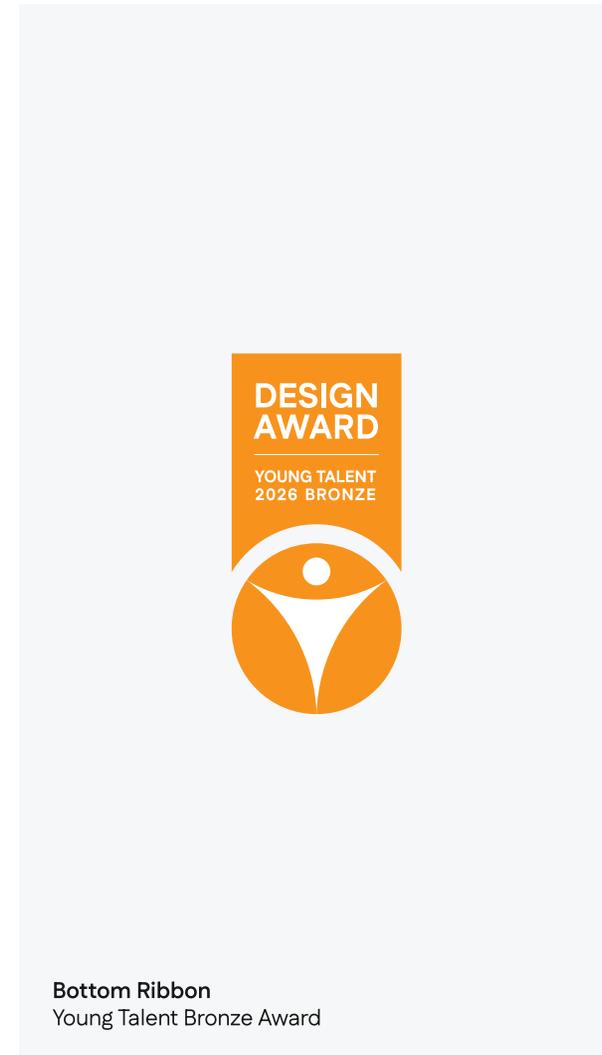

Online Badge Clear Space

Always maintain sufficient clear space around the badge to preserve its integrity, visibility, and visual impact.



Vertical Rectangle

The clear space around the rectangle badge is 1/3 of the symbol on all sides.



Horizontal Rectangle

The clear space around the rectangle badge is 1/3 of the symbol on all sides.

Online Badge Clear Space

Always maintain sufficient clear space around the badge to preserve its integrity, visibility, and visual impact.



Top Ribbon

The clear space around the ribbon badge is 1/3 of the symbol size on all sides. The bottom side is excluded from this rule, as the badge must align with the edge of the frame.



Bottom Ribbon

The clear space around the ribbon badge is 1/3 of the symbol size on all sides. The top side is excluded from this rule, as the badge must align with the edge of the frame.

Online Badge Minimum Size

To maintain legibility and brand integrity, the badge must never be displayed below the minimum size specified. This ensures clarity across all offline applications. When scaling the badge, always maintain its proportions to prevent distortion.

Online Badge Minimum Size

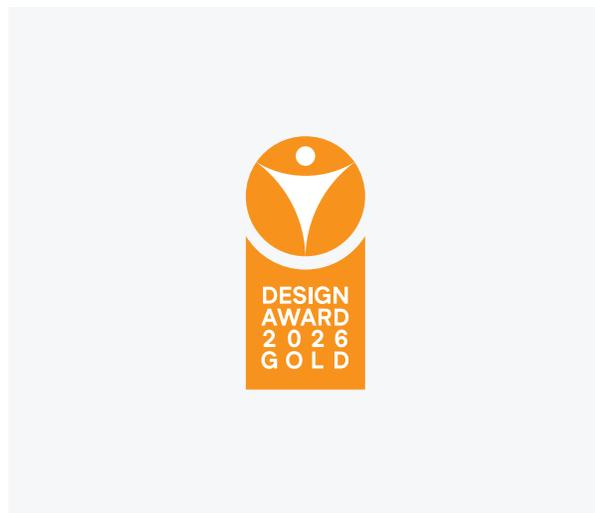
Top Ribbon

To maintain brand consistency across various backgrounds and applications, the badge is available in multiple colour formats. These variations ensure optimal legibility and adaptability in different contexts.



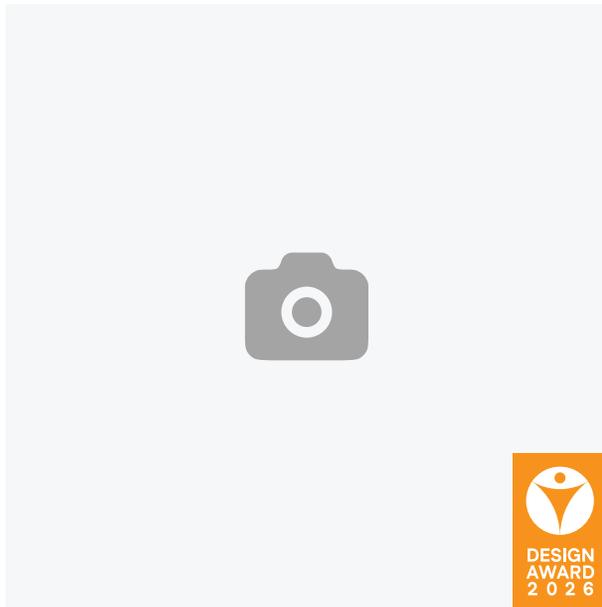
Online Badge Black and White Formats

The badge may be used in black and white when colour reproduction is not possible or when simplicity is required. These formats ensure the badge remains clear, legible, and consistency.

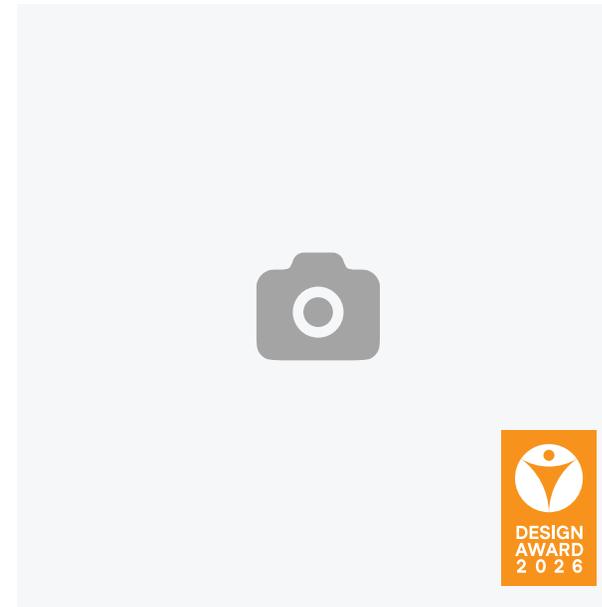


Rectangle Badge Usage

The badge should be used consistently across digital platforms to ensure clarity and visual consistency, while maintaining proper proportions, placement, and balance. There are two placement options for the rectangle badge. Examples of each placement method are shown below.



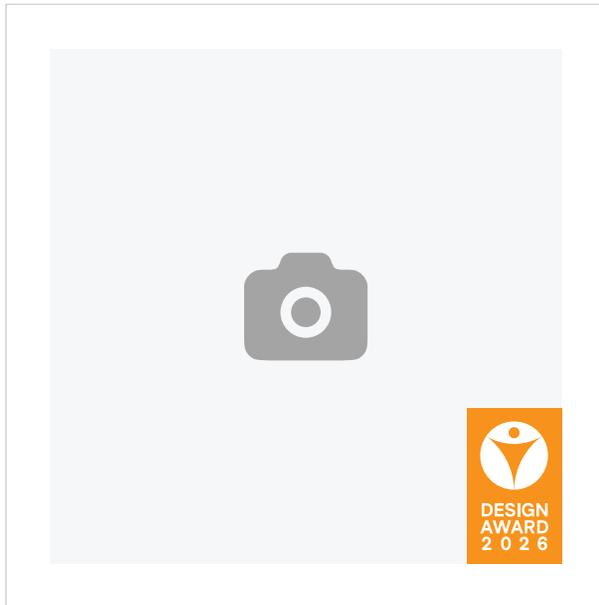
Place the badge without side or bottom padding.



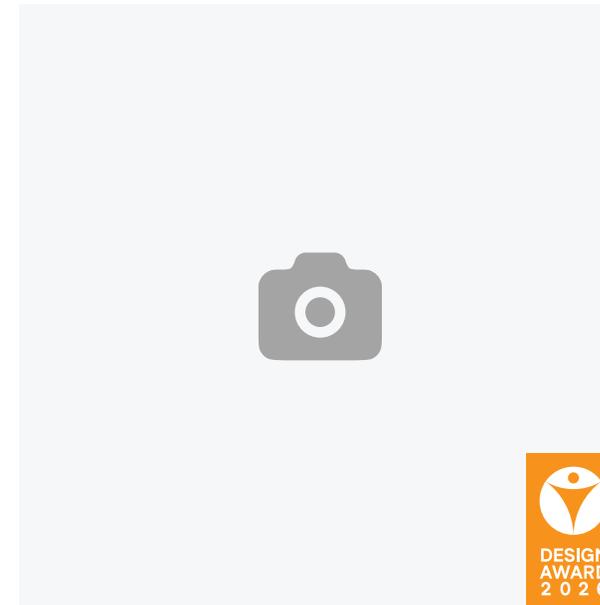
Place the badge with bottom and right padding equal to one-third (1/3) of the symbol size.

Rectangle Badge Usage for 1:1 Images

The badge should be used consistently across digital platforms to ensure clarity and visual consistency, while maintaining proper proportions, placement, and balance.



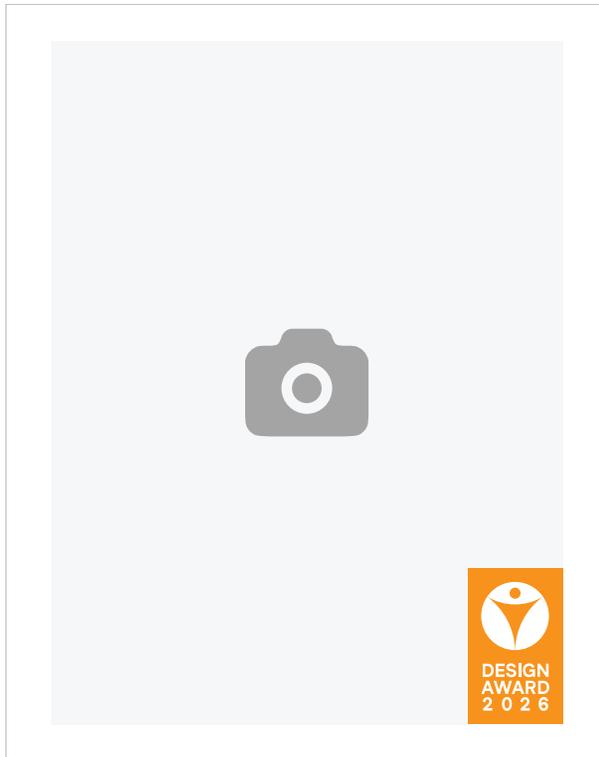
Used when the social post includes a defined frame or container.



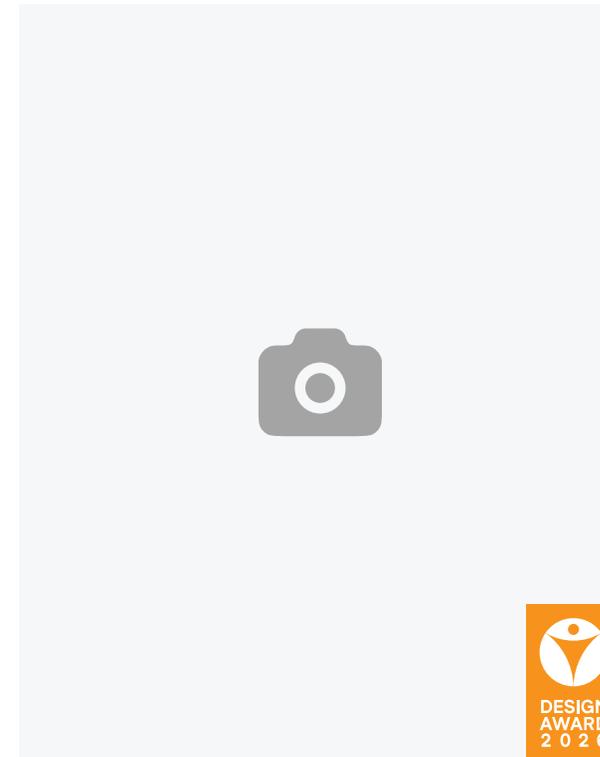
Used when the social post uses a full-bleed image without a frame.

The badge should be used consistently across digital platforms to ensure clarity and visual consistency, while maintaining proper proportions, placement, and balance.



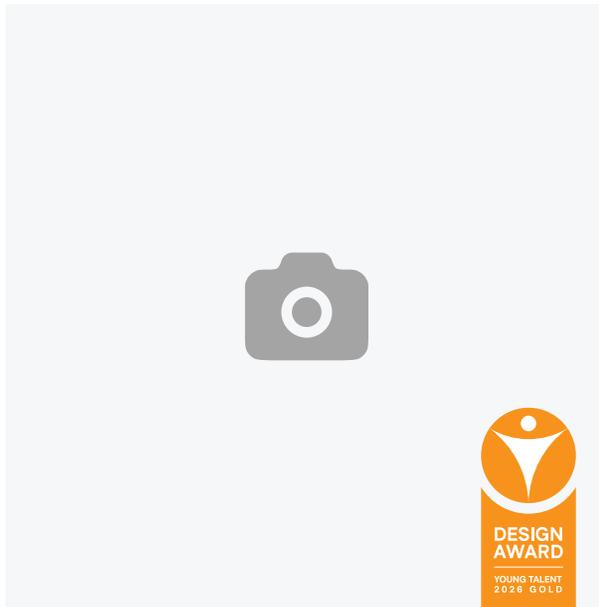
Used when the social post includes a defined frame or container.



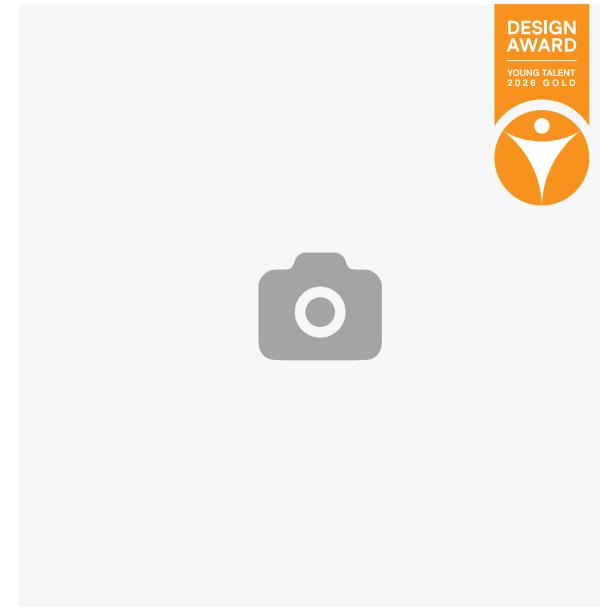
Used when the social post uses a full-bleed image without a frame.

Ribbon Badge Usage for 1:1 Images

The badge should be used consistently across digital platforms to ensure clarity and visual consistency, while maintaining proper proportions, placement, and balance.



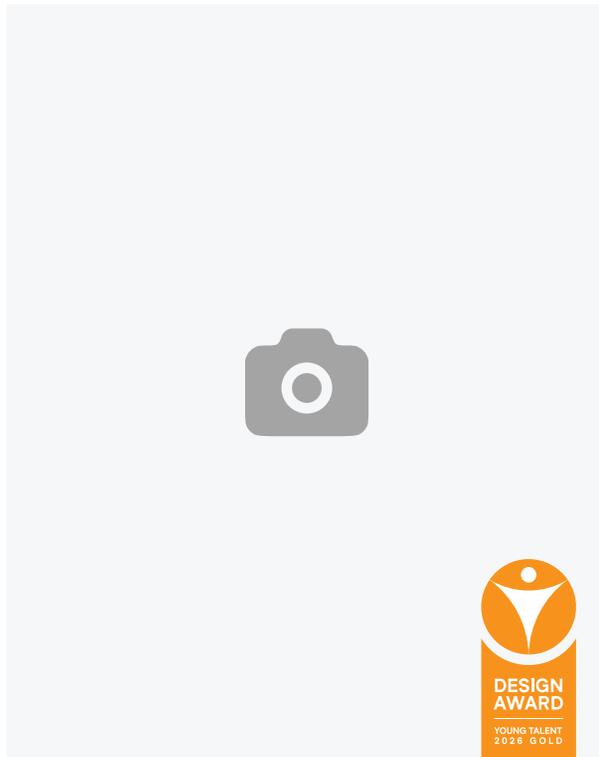
Always place the badge with no bottom padding, and maintain right padding equal to one-third (1/3) of the symbol size.



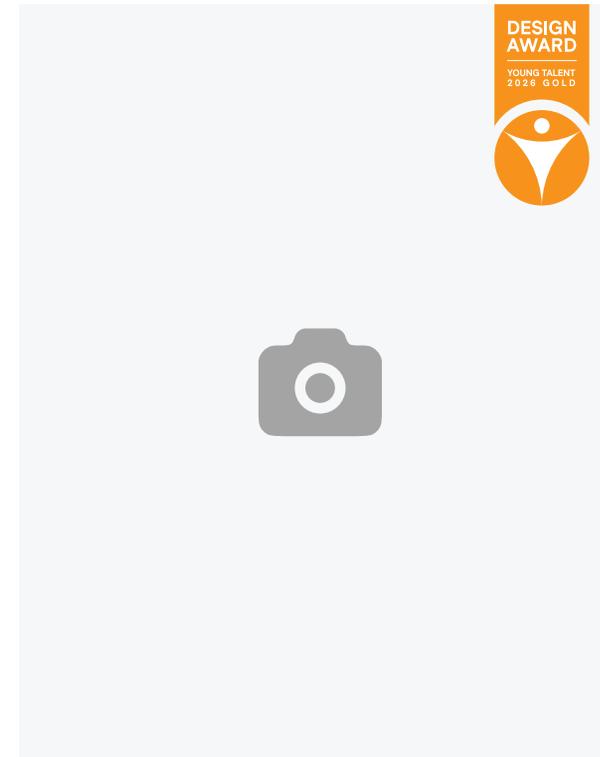
Always place the badge with no top padding, and maintain right padding equal to one-third (1/3) of the symbol size.

Ribbon Badge Usage for 3:4 Images

The badge should be used consistently across digital platforms to ensure clarity and visual consistency, while maintaining proper proportions, placement, and balance.



Always place the badge with no bottom padding, and maintain right padding equal to one-third (1/3) of the symbol size.



Always place the badge with no top padding, and maintain right padding equal to one-third (1/3) of the symbol size.

Online Badge Misuses

To maintain brand consistency, the badge should always be used correctly. Below are examples of incorrect usage of the badge.



Do not stretch or warp the badge in anyway.



Do not change any of the colour in the badge.



Do not attempt to apply strokes in anyway.



Do not apply any special effects to the badge.



Do not adjust saturation, brightness, contrast, or any other visual attributes within the badge.
